## KEYNOTE INTRODUCTION

In 2012 he made history by completing the longest unsupported polar expedition of all time. In 100 years of polar exploration no-one had EVER walked from the edge of Antarctica to the South Pole and back without assistance. Many had tried, none had succeeded. After skiing an epic 2275km over 89 days he and best mate, Cas made history.

You might remember the boys from a few years ago when they became the first, and only, people to have ever kayaked from Australia to New Zealand?

To put these achievements in perspective...

- 5500 people have stood on the summit of Everest.
- 112 people have skied to the South Pole unsupported
- and 12 astronauts have landed on the moon
- Only 3 people have ever skied from the coast of Antarctica to the south Pole and back.
